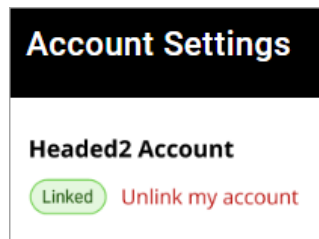
## Review favorite job opportunities

3. From Favorite Job Opportunities:
  - a. Select the title to display the opportunity details.
  - b. Click the **heart** icon to remove the opportunity from your favorites list.
  - c. Select **Back to Search** to find additional job opportunities.

## Unlink your Headed2 and Naviance accounts

1. To access Roadtrip Nation, go to **Careers** and select **Explore Roadtrip Nation Videos**.
2. Choose one of the search options to find videos of interest.

Search Option	Explanation
What is Your Road?	Choose a foundation and two interests to explore interviews with leaders with similar roads.
Interests	Choose an interest category such as medicine, art, or business to explore interviews with leaders in fields that align with your interests.
Themes	Choose a theme such as risk, failure, or determination to explore interviews in which leaders discuss their trials and learning related to the selected theme.
Leaders	Choose any of the leaders interviewed.
Playlist	Choose a pre-assembled playlist of video interviews.
